Building a Dental Home for Families

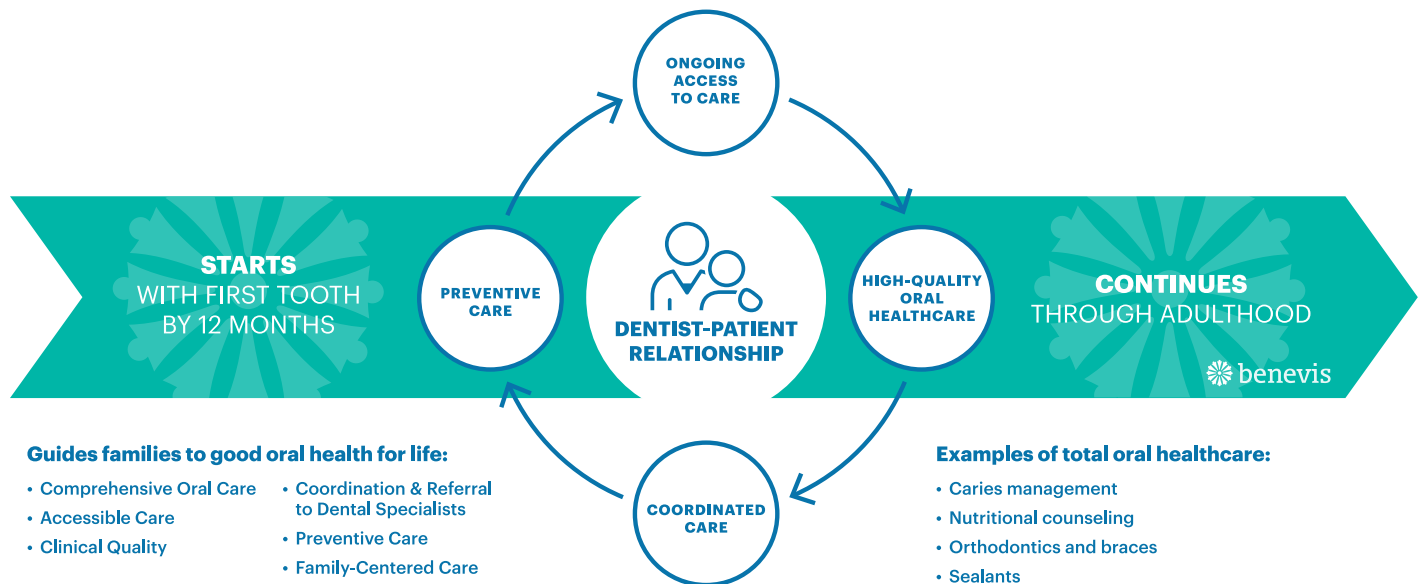
